We were approached by a resident about the state of some of the front doors in these roads. We contacted our councillors and they have been extremely helpful. A review of the state of these doors is currently being carried out and some new doors are being fitted.

#### Lakes

We have a representative on the City Council group investigating possible "Next Steps" for opening the lakes as an Urban Country Park, and attended the first meeting on July 8th. Anderson Group, the landowner, is preparing its proposals, and the Council are preparing various assessments. It is hoped that carefully controlled visits into the site can be arranged, so that members of the public can become better informed about the actual possibilities for the site.
