

Time to get out and about before winter!

1. Seed and plant swap

Saturday 26th September in Ancaster Way Car Park 10am till 1pm

Come and swap some seeds or plants or just pop along to have a chat. Garden advice on plants, solutions to common problems such as when to prune or cut plants back or how to improve the soil and growing conditions of your garden. Pick up a map to show you where to get free compost. If you have plants you no longer need, dig 'em up and bring some along (but do keep the roots moist in a pot or plastic bag). Swap them for something else or leave them with us and we will make sure they find a good home.

So far we have rosemary and pansies, alpine strawberries, erigeron (Mexican daisy) and some pond plants: hornwort, frogbit, brooklime. We have seeds of marigold, everlasting sweet pea, 4 o'clock flower, oxslip, californian poppy and bulbs of wild gladioli (gladiolus byzantinus). And we have a few indoor kits to get children started as gardeners. All free!
