Sunflower Competition – with prizes

There is a separate competition for adults and children. The plants will be judged in late August/early September. It would really help to cheer up the neighbourhood if the sunflowers were grown where everyone could enjoy them – front gardens or shared spaces? Free seeds will be available on the wall of 52 Birdwood Rd from the beginning of February or you can buy your own. Details of how to enter will be on the notice boards and in the next newsletter.

There will be 3 categories:

- 1. Largest diameter flower.
- 2. Tallest plant.
- 3. Largest number of flowers on a single plant.

You can either plant the seeds outdoors or start them off indoors. Some tips:

Outdoors: Plant the seeds in a sunny place, no more than 3 cms deep about 15 cms apart after the soil has thoroughly warmed, from mid-April to late May. You can plant multiple seeds and thin them to the strongest contenders when the plants are 10 - 15 cms tall.

Indoors: Grow your sunflowers in individual containers with drainage holes and well-drained potting mix. This accommodates the plant's fast growth and prevents sitting water. Loo-roll centres are ideal as they can be planted out without disturbing the roots. Place the sunflowers in an area where they're exposed to at least six hours of full sunlight per day – an east or south-facing window is ideal. Plant out when plant is 10 - 15 cm tall.

Warning - slugs and snails love the seedlings!
